- 75% of funds raised stay local, right here in Southeast Wisconsin, going to underserved women for education, screening treatment and support in an eight-county area.
- The other 25% goes to world-class research. We're one of 125 affiliates of Susan G. Komen for the Cure, the world's largest breast cancer research funder.
- Komen Southeast Wisconsin grant funds are restricted to breast cancer programs to not-for-profit organizations.
- Every two years, we assess our community needs in regards to breast cancer. In 2009, we identified these priorities: increase breast health screenings, access to diagnostics and access to treatment.
- Susan G. Komen for the Cure is the world's largest private funder of breast cancer research and community health programs.
- With more than \$1.3 billion invested to date, Komen for the Cure is moving ahead with its commitment to invest \$2 billion by the year 2017.
- Every major advance in the fight against breast cancer has been touched by Susan G. Komen for the Cure.
- Susan G. Komen has helped train more than 400 breast cancer researchers and funded more than 1,800 research projects over the past 26 years.
